

## Montreal Council on Foreign Relations (MCFR - CORIM) Fellowships

[Montreal Council on Foreign Relations \(MCFR - CORIM\)](#) offers fellowships for outstanding PhD students who are planning an internship abroad (outside Canada) for a duration of 6-12 months. **Application deadline: September 15<sup>th</sup> 2013**

The Montreal Council of Foreign Relations (MCFR) is a non-profit, non-partisan, private organization. The MCFR's mission is to promote greater knowledge of international affairs and to encourage closer cooperation between various entities that share an interest in international matters. The MCFR is now offering a prize in the form of a fellowship that will come to reinforce its educational mission and lengthen its social reach.

### Summary of Eligibility:

- The student has to be enrolled in a full-time doctoral program at McGill,
- Be 35 years old or younger,
- Be a Canadian citizen,
- The students' research should focus on international relations.
- The internship must be outside of Canada.
- It is an annual award of \$20,000, non-renewable, for six to twelve months.

### How to Apply:

Students have to submit a **complete application package** containing the application form, a CV, a list of applications (where applicable), a description of the research project and all official University level transcripts **to their academic unit by September 15<sup>th</sup> 2013**. Each **academic unit may submit one candidate to GPS by September 30<sup>th</sup> 2013**. Following an internal pre-selection trial, McGill may submit one application to the Board of MCFR as the final candidate. The Board of MCFR will meet individually with each of the four finalists (one from each Montreal University) and review complete files. The final decision on the fellowship winner will be taken at end of November 2013.
