

## ODQ documents

Hi Everyone

Please note that there is going to be a credit of \$77.50 on your equipment accounts. Charges for photocopies during 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year will be added shortly to your invoice. I'll send you each an e-mail with the exact amount.

Yesterday, you received your ODQ license application. If you are requesting a licence only next year, please keep the documents and contact Carole Pigeon from the ODQ a month or so before you require your license.

### **Quebec License**

Basically, if you wish to obtain your license to practice in Quebec now, you have to fill in the application form and return it by the deadline. It must be received at the ODQ offices by May 10<sup>th</sup> at the latest! No extensions are granted. If you are really late, you would have to deliver them personally to the ODQ office. However, since you have an exam on May 10<sup>th</sup>, I would suggest handling the documents as soon as possible to avoid problems.

### **Quebec GPR or Specialization Program**

If you are entering a multidisciplinary residency or specialty program in Quebec, your fee is reduced to \$298.35. You have to submit the Application for Exemption Form and have it signed by me (commissioner for oaths).

Your program director has to complete and sign the back of the form (the section where it says: OR ratify by .....).

### **Students not requesting a Quebec License**

If you only want to obtain your license next year, please complete and sign (before a commissioner for oaths) the Application for Exemption form.

In the application, you are asked to provide your NDEB certificate – they will accept the e-mail from the NDEB which you received with your score.

Regarding the payment for the 2013-2014 assessment (\$1,483.35), there may be an additional amount of \$250 following the Annual General Meeting on May 28<sup>th</sup>. I would suggest sending two cheques to cover the two amounts.

The official oath of office and licensing ceremonies will take place May 28<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 pm. in room M/1. I'm hoping all 4<sup>th</sup> year students will attend (you can bring two guests). The McGill Convocation Ceremony will finish around 4:15 and attending the ODQ ceremony will be a special event to mark the end of the graduation day ceremonies.

If you have questions once you've read through the documents, let me know. Please contact me to be sure I will be in my office to sign the application form and be sure to have a passport sized photo which I will sign along with your liability insurance form.
