

## Radiology Badges September 2013

Welcome Everyone,

Starting in September 2013, you will each be provided with a Dosimeter (radiology badge) from Health Canada. It is a device that records the amount of radiation to which you have been exposed, and this cumulative record is kept over your lifetime.

It is to be worn for your protection as you will be taking radiographs. It is important to take it off at the end of the day so that it does not go through the washing machine along with your scrubs and to store it in a safe place away from light or heat, such as your locker.

Every 3 months, you will be asked to return it to replace it with another one. If you lose it, a charge of \$82.50 will be added to your account as this is our cost to replace it.

To arrange these badges, Health Canada requires your Social Insurance Number and I am missing the following individuals:
