Institute courses include **Principles of Epidemiology** and **Advanced Methods in Observational Studies, Design and Conduct of Clinical Trials** and **Comparative Effectiveness Research: Outcome Measurement**

Two new courses this summer are, **Principles of Disease Eradication**, taught by Dr. Joel Breman, Senior Scientist of the Fogarty International Center of the U.S. National Institutes of Health, and **Introduction to Systematic Reviews and Meta-Analysis** taught by Dr. Tianjing Li, and Dr. Kay Dickersin, Director of the US Cochrane Center.
