The Southern Illinois University School of Dental Medicine is seeking applications for a full-time, tenure or clinical track position in the Section of Endodontics, Department of Applied Dental Medicine. Responsibilities include didactic and clinical teaching in the predoctoral program and service to the University. The candidate will also have the opportunity to mentor and teach residents in the graduate Endodontic program. For tenure track appointments independent research and scholarly activity is also expected. Working in collaboration with other faculty, both in research and teaching, is strongly encouraged. Extramural faculty practice is available.

A D.M.D. or D.D.S. degree from a CODA accredited dental school, specialty training in Endodontics, board eligibility or certification, experience in teaching, and interest and/or experience in research are desired. Candidates holding an M.S. degree are preferred. Applicants must be licensed to practice dentistry in the State of Illinois, or be able to meet the requirements for permanent licensure in Illinois. Academic rank and salary are commensurate with qualifications.

SIU/SDM is a suburban campus located in the St. Louis metropolitan area. Applicants should submit a letter of intent, curriculum vitae and three letters of reference to Dr. Bruce E.
